


IAB Sidekick Style Guide

Description

- 1. On load, In-Page Display unit delivers with call to action to expand Sidekick
- 2. Upon user click of the expand button, Sidekick loads in the right gutter of the page
- 3. Sidekick pushes page content horizontally to the left
- 4. User engages with all of the interactive features of the Sidekick. Page content is still visible and fully interactive
- 5. Upon the Sidekick closing, the ad collapses and page content is pushed back to the right





Storyboard

1. In-page Display unit delivers with call to action to expand Sidekick



2. Sidekick appears on right and expands, "pushing" editorial content leftward



Technical specifications

In-page Display

Dimension: 300x250 px (Additional options include IAB 300x600 and IAB Billboard 970x250)

Initial Load File Size: 50KB max

Source Format: FLA and exported SWF, Flash 9+, AS2 or AS3

Animation Time: 15 seconds max

Animation Loops: Loops within 15 seconds max animation time permitted

Frame Rate: 24 FPS max

Border: Creative must contain 1-pixel border

Expand Method: On click or rollover after visual three-second countdown

Sidekick

Dimension: 850x700 px

Initial Load File Size: 100KB max

Sub-load: Additional 100KB max upon user interaction via click (up to five sub-loads max)

Source Format: FLA and exported SWF, Flash 9+, AS2 or AS3

Frame Rate: 24 FPS max

Allowed Expanded Directions: Expands in right gutter only. Appears to push page to the left

Border: Creative must contain 1-pixel wide border

Close button: Must be present and clearly defined at all times in the top right corner of ad

Alt image

Dimension: 300x250 px (Additional options include IAB 300x600 and IAB Billboard 970x250)

Source Format: GIF, JPG, or layered PSD

File Size: 50KB max

Animation Time: 15 seconds max

Animation Loops: Loops within 15 seconds max animation time permitted

Border: Creative must contain 1-pixel border

Media assets

Video Permitted: Yes. May be host-initiated

Video Delivery: Progressive or streaming. Varies with publisher preference

Video Duration: 30 seconds max

Video Controls: Must contain toggles for Play/Pause and Audio On/Off

Sound Permitted: Yes. User-initiated on click only (auto play in expansion if click to expand)

General settings

CPU Usage: Between 20% and 30% after initial file load. An initial spike of up to 60% is acceptable in the first five seconds

Ad Tag Delivery Method: script, iframe, or friendly iframe

Third-party Tags Accepted: Yes

Third-party Tracking Accepted: Yes (Impressions, Clicks, Research Tags)
